

Breed Determination Form

Manteca Police - Animal Control

The purpose of this form is to document breed determination in cases where the dog owner is not sure if their unaltered dog(s) are considered by Manteca to fall into the category of "pit bull" as specified under Section 6.10.040 of the Manteca Municipal Code (MMC). When requested by a dog owner, an Animal Control Officer (ACO) will initiate the form and make a determination of breed. If determined that the dog is a pit bull the owner may initiate an appeal within five (5) business days of the ACO's determination. The Support Services Manager will review the owner's supporting data for the appeal and make a final determination of breed no more than thirty (30) days after receipt of the appeal request. Any exceptions to the requirement to spay/neuter pit bulls shall be in accordance with Section 6.10.050 of the MMC. The owner shall be responsible for the transport of any dog(s) to/from the Manteca Animal Shelter.
