RTD Talk to Me Maps

Audio and Tactile Maps of Transit Boarding Areas

San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) has a new service that makes getting around much easier for riders who are visually impaired.

Talk to Me Maps are amazing audio and tactile maps of transit boarding areas. Using the braille map book and SmartPen, riders are told aloud where to board their bus.

Orientation and Mobility instructors will work with riders who are visually impaired to orient them to RTD's system using the maps. Riders can use braille to read the book and find the appropriate station map. Next, they can use the SmartPen to hear an audio message telling them what bus routes stop at the boarding location they have selected.
