YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST THIS BUSINESS IS IN VIOLATION OF AN EXECUTIVE ORDER

- Due to the outbreak of COVID-19, the State of California is in the midst of a worldwide life-threatening pandemic.
- Cases of infections and deaths in California and America are on the rise every single day.
- Presently, there is no known vaccine or cure.
- On March 19, 2020, the Governor of California issued Executive Order N-33-20 (the "Order"), mandating all individuals living in the State of California to stay at home or at their place of residence, except as needed to maintain continuity of operations of the 16 critical infrastructure sectors.
- This business is <u>not</u> a part of a critical sector and continues to operate in violation of the Order, hampering our ability to slow transmission of the disease and increasing the risk to the public from COVID-19.
- As the well-being of our communities and the preservations of public health are the utmost importance, noncompliance will *not* be tolerated.
- Any person who refuses or willfully neglects to comply with an emergency order is guilty of a
 misdemeanor, punishable by fine and/or imprisonment. (Government Code § 8665; Health & Safety
 Code § 120275.) In addition, there are civil and administrative penalties that can be imposed upon you
 as a result of continued operation.
- Further operation of this business in violation of the Order shall be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- Immediate and complete compliance with the Order is expected. If you fail to comply with this Order, then we will move forward with the tools at our disposal to close the operations of the business to protect the health safety of the people of in our community.
