Per California Building Code, Section 111, "No building or structure shall be used or occupied, and no change in the existing occupancy classification of a building or structure or portion thereof shall be made until the building official has issued as a Certificate of Occupancy..."

This sign off list shall apply to all commercial remodels, tenant infill's, additions, and new Commercial buildings in order to be able to obtain a Certificate of Occupancy:

- □ **Planning Division 209-456-8500** Contact the Planning Division when the exterior of the building and all site work is completed. This should occur as early as possible so that any outstanding items or corrections can be addressed. (2 weeks prior to final is recommended)
 - Landscaping Contact Planning when all landscape is completed. Ideally this should occur as early as possible so that any outstanding items or corrections can be addressed.
- □ Engineering Division 209-456-8580 or contact your Construction Inspector (209-639-5964 or 209 923-0528) directly -
 - Engineering Contact you Construction Inspector when all sitework is completed. Ideally this should occur as early as possible so that any outstanding items or corrections can be addressed.
- □ **Fire Prevention 209-456-8340** Contact the Fire Prevention Division when the all fire and life safety, fire sprinklers, exits, door hardware, etc. are completed. This should occur as early as possible so that any outstanding items or corrections can be addressed.
- □ San Joaquin County Environmental Health 209-468-3420 If County Health has been involved in your project due to the serving of food or for any other reason they shall be contacted for a final inspection.
- Building Safety Division 209-456-8550 Building Safety cannot issue any type of Certificate of Occupancy without all entities mentioned above approving the project as complete. Contact Building Safety for final inspection when the building is complete, corrections have been addressed, special inspection reports provided, etc. Pending approval of the Building Safety Division, your permit may be signed off as complete and a Certificate of Occupancy issued.
