What is a Housing Element Update?

- Goals, policies, and actions to address our current and projected housing needs
- Inventory of sites suitable to accommodate the housing needs allocation for 2023-2031
- Assessment of financial and programmatic resources for housing development, rehabilitation, and preservation
- Analysis of fair housing issues and constraints

The Housing Needs and Priorities Survey seeks input from Manteca's residents, business owners, and interested parties to identify current housing conditions, needs, and priorities. The community survey addresses the needs of populations with unique housing needs, including seniors, persons with a disability, including developmental disabilities, large families with 5 or more persons, female-headed households with children present, farmworkers, and the unhoused.
