Q.4.1. I have a concern with the Q&A No. 3, A 3.8 states that the DBE 15-G is required to be submitted at the time of the bid, referencing spec. 00439. No where in that spec. section states that. It in fact states the opposite on page 59, "If the DBE Commitment form, Exhibit 15-G, is not submitted with the bid, it must be completed and submitted by all bidders to the Agency within five (5) days of bid opening. If the bidder does not submit the DBE Commitment form within the specified time, the Agency will find the bidder's bid nonresponsive." Please verify.

A.4.1. Q&A 4.1 supersedes Q&A 3.8.

If the bidder is able to submit at the time of bid the DBE Commitment Form, Exhibit 15-G, then please include it in the bid proposal.

If the DBE Commitment form, Exhibit 15-G, is not submitted with the bid, it must be completed and submitted by all bidders to the Agency within five (5) days of bid opening. If the DBE goal is not met, the contractor also needs to complete and submit the DBE GFE documentation Exhibit 15-H Proposer/Contractor Good Faith Efforts and supporting documentations as described in Local Assistance Procedures Manual (LAPM) Chapter 9, Section 9.8 within 5 (five) days of bid opening. The contractor may submit via email to the contact person listed on the specifications Section 00020 Invitation to Bid.
